Morning Worship**

New Testament Reading: Acts 16: 6-12a

They went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia. When they had come opposite Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them; so, passing by Mysia, they went down to Troas. During the night Paul had a vision: there stood a man of Macedonia pleading with him and saying, 'Come over to Macedonia and help us.' When he had seen the vision, we immediately tried to cross over to Macedonia, being convinced that God had called us to proclaim the good news to them. We set sail from Troas and took a straight course to Samothrace, the following day to Neapolis, and from there to Philippi, which is a leading city of the district of Macedonia and a Roman colony.

Psalm 147: vv1-11

Praise the Lord! How good it is to sing praises to our God; for he is gracious, and a song of praise is fitting.

***The Lord builds up Jerusalem;
he gathers the outcasts of Israel.***

*He heals the broken-hearted,
and binds up their wounds.*

***He determines the number of the stars;
he gives to all of them their names.***

*Great is our Lord, and abundant in power;
his understanding is beyond measure.*

***The Lord lifts up the downtrodden;
he casts the wicked to the ground.***

*Sing to the Lord with thanksgiving;
make melody to our God on the lyre.*

***He covers the heavens with clouds,
prepares rain for the earth,
makes grass grow on the hills.***

*He gives to the animals their food,
and to the young ravens when they cry.*

***His delight is not in the strength
of the horse, nor his pleasure in the
speed of a runner;***

*but the Lord takes pleasure in those who fear
him, in those who hope in his steadfast love.*

***Glory be to the Father,
and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit;
as it was in the beginning,
is now and ever shall be
world without end. Amen***

Gospel: Luke 10: 1-9

After this the Lord appointed seventy others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go. He said to them, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest. Go on your way. See, I am sending you out like lambs into the midst of wolves. Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals; and greet no one on the road. Whatever house you enter, first say, "Peace to this house!" And if anyone is there who shares in peace, your peace will rest on that person; but if not, it will return to you. Remain in the same house, eating and drinking whatever they provide, for the labourer deserves to be

paid. Do not move about from house to house. Whenever you enter a town and its people welcome you, eat what is set before you; cure the sick who are there, and say to them, "The kingdom of God has come near to you."

Almighty God, you called Luke the physician, whose praise is in the Gospel, to be an evangelist and physician of the soul: by the grace of the Spirit and through the wholesome medicine of the Gospel, give your Church the same love and power to heal; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.
